Glory on the face of Moses	Glory on the face of Jesus
Face veiled – people could not behold glory	Unveiled face so we can be changed into same glory
Glory temporary	Glory permanent

People said “speak to us no more”	God speaks through man to pray exactly what He wishes
50 speaks of deliverance from debt, slavery, return temporal possessions.	50 speaks of deliverance from law, (ceremonial) sin, eternal.
Trumpet voice, quaking, thundering, lighting, Lord descends in fire	Quaking (shaking) Tongues of fire, Holy Spirit is given
People afraid of the power of God	People blessed with God’s power

Necessary for salvation	Not necessary for salvation
For newest of life	For times of refreshing / power
Praying from human heart	Praying from God's heart
Almost impossible to pray unceasingly	Gift makes it virtually possible to pray unceasingly
Natural prayer	Supernatural prayer
Restored around 1500 AD	Restored around 1910 AD Azusa St.
Comes first to the believer	Comes second to the believer
Power (John 1:12) to become a son of God for receiving Him	Power from on high as a "Promise of My Father" Luke 24:49
Power is exousia in Greek, means liberty, sense of ability (Phil 4:13)	Power is dunamis in Greek, means mighty work, miracle, (dynamite)
Given right away when decision is made to repent and receive Christ	Given after salvation, may require waiting on God (tarry)
Not all who keep Passover keep Pentecost	Must have kept Passover to experience Pentecost
Enemy fights natural man from receiving Christ	Enemy fights believer from receiving Holy Spirit supernatural power
Given to the natural person	Given to the spiritual person
